Our Material Recovery Facility (MRF) and educational presentation plays an increasingly important role in the diversion of Construction and Demolition (C&D) waste away from landfill and helps to maximise the value of recyclable material recovered.

Come and safely view over half a kilometre of linked conveyors and plant line. We process over 200,000 tonnes of C&D waste per annum to help improve Western Australia's environmental credentials. This diversion process is key in improving the State's waste recovery performance and will contribute towards its waste reduction targets over the next decade.*

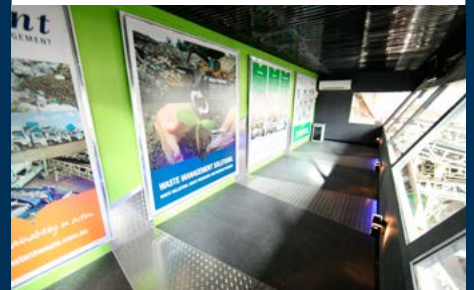

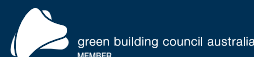
