Hazardous & Industrial Disposal Collection System

We are authorised to remove most categories of controlled packaged waste as specified on the Department of Environmental Regulation's (DER) category listing. In addition, we can arrange the safe and effective disposal or hazardous waste that requires specialist equipment and licensing.





Instant Waste Management provides environmentally responsible hazardous waste disposal services to clients in Perth and right across Western Australia. We understand there are times where waste on site cannot simply be placed in a skip bin for removal. This could cover situations where hazardous materials have been found on site (e.g. asbestos on old sites), or the material was once used in the business but now is required to be disposed.

We have many clients that have a need to dispose of hazardous waste in a safe and proper manner, but simply do know know what to do.

Instant Waste Management can arrange a site visit to identify and plan the safe and effective removal of hazardous waste. Typically we are engaged to dispose of the following hazardous waste streams.

- Asbestos waste this must be packaged in accordance with Government regulatory requirements.
- Chemicals
- Contaminated and other materials requiring special disposal (eg. used garnet from sand blasting activities, contaminated soils etc.).
- Hydrocarbons
- Lubricants
- Oils (engine oils, hydraulic oils, soiled materials etc.).
- Soiled and out of date foods.
- Unknown waste we can offer a sample and testing service to access the nature of the waste and then provide an estimate or quote to dispose of the identified waste.

We also receive several requests for the management, disposal and/or destruction of other industrial waste which although is not hazardous, still needs to be disposed of or destroyed for commercial purposes. We have carried out activities such as;

- Destruction and disposal of old and surplus stock to ensure it does not find its way into the second hand/black market.
- Destruction and disposal of imported materials that do not meet Australian standards.
